

Selection of Wines

BUBBLES

- 1 **Bollinger Special Cuvée, Champagne** £ 80
Absolutely Fabulous. Bollinger has glitzy associations, but beneath the glitz lies seriously high-quality fizz. Unusual for a Champagne, where richness and toasty flavours are usually the result of aging.
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- 2 **Taittinger Brut Réserve NV, Champagne** £ 60
Aged in the oldest cellars in Champagne, This 90 Parker Point fizz weaves notes of peach, acacia, citrus and honey through the divine bubbles that lead to a beautifully elegant finish.
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- 3 **Oeil de Perdrix Rosé, Champagne** £ 40
Meaning 'eye of the partridge', this pale salmon pink rosé Champagne exhibits enticing complexity. Delicate in style and with a perfect weight of fruit.
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- 4 **La Gioiosa, Prosecco** £ 25
La Gioiosa has a gleaming trophy cabinet. It's an expert in all things Prosecco. Once squeezed, the grapes that make this are immediately chilled to 0°. It's the secret that brings oodles of floral and pear aromas to your flute.

ROSÉ

- 5 **Les Frères Lumière Côtes du Rhône, Rosé 2020** £ 25
A classic blend of Grenache, Syrah and Cinsault that's pale in colour but fragrant on the nose. Expect delicate notes of red fruit and peach, with a crisp palate and a streak of minerality.
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- 6 **The Guv'nor Rosé, Spain** £ 25
A blend of Garnacha, Bobal and Tempranillo grapes. With the characteristics of Nectarine, Raspberry and Strawberries.

WHITE

- 7 **Domaine Roger Neveu 'Côte des Embouffants', Sancerre 2020** £ 35
This elegant Sauvignon has all the hallmarks of top shelf Sancerre. Taking from four carefully chosen plots, from vines on a variety of soils, Les Tuilières is crisp, mineral and full of precise lime and gooseberry.
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- 8 **Mud House Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough NZ 2020** £ 25
Intensely refreshing and bursting with tropical-fruit aromas. Think passionfruit, grapefruit, melon and citrus.
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- 9 **Santa Rita 'Medalla Real', Chardonnay 2020** £ 25
Sourced mainly from the Limari Valley, the northern most vineyard district in Chile. This Chardonnay is bright golden in colour, with a faint green tint. The nose offers good ripeness, with citrus aromas turning to a softer apple.

RED

- 10 **Rioja Reserva, Marqués de Riscal 2016** £ 35
Marqués de Riscal is one of Rioja's oldest wineries. It's only with almost two centuries of experience that you can craft a summer-fruit-and-vanilla-packed red this delectable. It's silky, elegant and jammy red in colour.
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- 11 **Luis Felipe Edwards Gran Reserva, Merlot 2019** £ 25
Fresh. Fruity. It's got incredible intensity from ripening in the Colchagua sun. Think strawberry, black cherry and cassis. A lovely ripe, velvety texture complements this moreish fruitiness.
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- 12 **Malbec Mendoza, Alamos 2019** £ 25
The Malbec from Alamos is a multi-layered, balanced red wine from the Argentine wine-growing region of Mendoza. It is a pure grape variety. With cherry and fruit aromas of blackcurrant, mixed with a hint of chocolate.
